

Irish Sea Marine Sector Cruise in Company Terms and Conditions:

The Cruise In Company organisers shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/participator, his/her skipper or crew, as a result of their taking part in the event. Moreover, every owner/participator warrants the suitability of his/her yacht/boat for the event.

1. By signing the declaration below, participants accept that they are responsible for themselves, their crew, and their yachts/boats whether afloat or ashore.
2. Nothing done by the organisers (i.e. Event management team, the clubs, patrol craft and anyone helping to run the event) will relieve participants of their responsibilities.
3. By launching (or putting to sea) participants imply the suitability of their yachts/boats and the competence of the skipper and crew for the expected forecast conditions.
4. The provision of patrol craft (where provided) does not relieve participants of their responsibilities.
5. The safety of a yacht/boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/participant who must ensure that the yacht/boat is fully found, thoroughly seaworthy and manned by a crew sufficient in number and experience who are physically fit to face bad weather. The owner/participator must be satisfied as to the soundness of the hull, spars, rigging, sails, motor and all gear. He/she must ensure that all safety equipment is properly maintained, stowed and in date and that the crew know where it is kept and how it is used.
